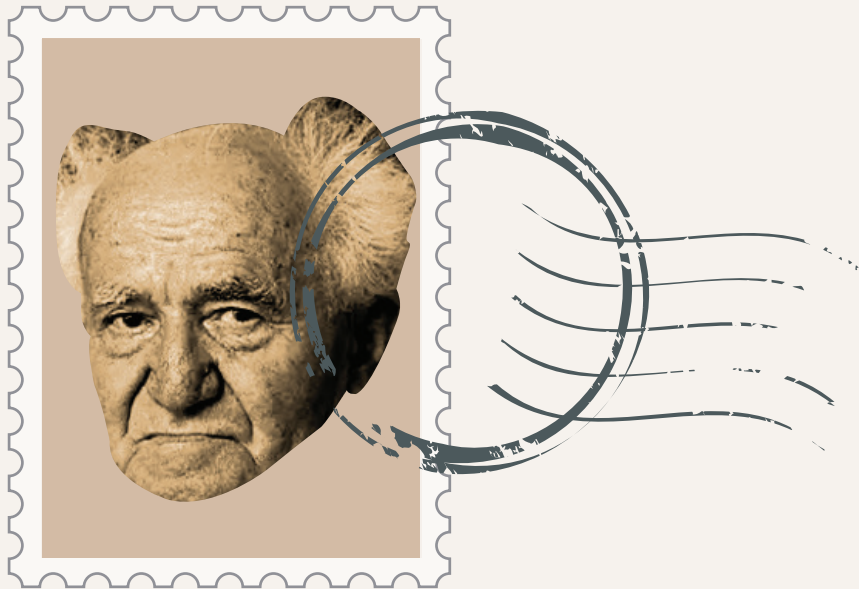




Riddle #1

I was born in Poland in 1886. In my childhood, we experienced acts of anti-Semitism perpetrated by our own neighbors, and it was quite clear to us that we need a state of our own.

At the age of 20, I came to the Land of Israel as a pioneer, and was one of the founders of the Histadrut, the General Organization of Workers in Israel, which advocated workers' rights. In 1948, I had the great merit of announcing the establishment of a Jewish State in the Land of Israel, and served as Israel's first prime-minister!

After retiring, I went to the Negev desert and lived in a little cabin in Sde-Boker, because my dream had always been for Israel to develop and populate the Negev desert.
